Tools of the Trade Table 1 lists all Apple IIGS technical

manuals. They may be obtained from Addison-Wesley. Books covering 65816 and PD16 programming are also noted. Kudos go to Gary Little's book. Exploring the Apple IIGS. Step by step, it will teach you how to program in the new environment. Gary has a knack for presenting difficult material in a palatable fashion. A program disk may be acquired for an additional sum. Michael Fischer's extremely useful Apple IIGS Technical Reference is drier but more comprehensive.

- The Byte Works has written both the ORCA/M Assembler for the Apple IIGS and the APW Assembler, which comes with the Apple IIGS Programmer's Workshop Reference manual. The latter is my PD16 assembler of choice, for reasons cited in another

section of this article. PRODOS 16 ENVIRONMENT

An operating system stands between the hardware and firmware and the application. It enables the user to communicate with mass storage media. The desktop metaphor and graphics are characteristic of PD16 but need not be used in PD16 applications. The APW Assembler is an example of a text-based program that runs under PD16.

The System Disk The System Disk provided by Apple Computer lets you execute programs that run under PD16 or PD8. The contents of version 3.1 occupy 1,326 blocks (663K) on a 3.5-inch disk and are noted in Table 2. A complete disk ideally contains all of the files on the System Disk. An application disk requires only those files which assure that the application will operate properly. Mandatory files are starred in Table 2. For a review of earlier system disks, consult Ken Kashmarek's article, cited at the end of this article.

On booting the unaltered System Disk, you
